Day 1: (D & flight meals) Adelaide / Singapore

Sun 21 July 2024

Arrive Adelaide international airport 3 hours prior for your 9:10am Singapore Airlines flight to Singapore. Upon arrival at 3:10pm, you will be met at the airport at the Arrivals Hall where you will meet your Singapore representative and escort to your waiting coach for your transfer to your hotel. Enjoy our welcome dinner in house. Accommodation: Peninsula Excelsior Hotel | 2 nights.

Day 2: (BLD) Sightseeing in Singapore

Mon 22 July 2024

After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of this incredible city. Singapore is a small place but has so much to offer. We will be joined by a local guide to take in a tour of the major landmarks such as the Botanical Gardens, Chinatown, Merlion Park and Little India. Enjoy a cruise along the river and lunch. Tonight, we experience the Night Safari. Relax on your tram ride while exploring jungle as the mystery unfolds after dark as we travel through 6 geographical zones to witness the natural habitats of more than 1000 nocturnal creatures. Includes dinner.

Day 3: (B & flight meals) Vancouver arrival

Tue 23 July 2024

An early transfer to Singapore Airport to check in 3 hours prior to your Singapore Airlines 7:25am departure to Vancouver. In house meals included on flight. Upon arrival at 7:10am, we will be met by our local guide. Transfer by coach to the hotel for early check-in. Rest of the day at leisure and overnight Vancouver. Accommodation: Vancouver Marriott Pinnacle Downtown – including early check-in | 1 Night

Day 4: Vancouver / Victoria

Wed 24 July 2024

Departure to the Tsawwassen ferry terminal where you will board a ferry for the 1.5 hour crossing of the Georgia Strait through the beautiful Gulf Islands. Keep a lookout for your chance to view some of the local wildlife! Upon arrival, we will visit the famous Butchart Gardens, one of the most spectacular floral displays in Canada. Created early last century from a stone quarry, the different areas of the garden are planted such that they bloom year-round. Some of the highlights of the Gardens include the Italian gardens, Japanese gardens, the English rose garden and the Star Pond. Continue to your hotel downtown Victoria for overnight. Accommodation: Inn at Laurel Point – Laurel Wing | 2 Nights

Day 5: Victoria

Thu 25 July 2024

Your morning city tour will show you the main sights of Beacon Hill park, Beach Drive, Bastion Square, the Famous Empress Hotel and the Inner harbour with the BC Parliament buildings. Afternoon at leisure or for optional activities. Overnight Victoria.

Day 6: Victoria / Sun Peaks

Fri 26 July 2024

Early today transfer to Swartz Bay for the 90-minute cruise to Tsawwassen. From Tsawwassen we travel east through the fertile Fraser Valley, an important agricultural region dotted with dairy and berry and u-pick farms. Continue along the Coquihalla Highway into the desert-like country of the Thompson-Okanagan region. Sage brush and rolling hills dominate the landscape, making a startling contrast from the lush coastal mountain

Day 7: Sun Peaks / Valemount

Sat 27 July 2024

Today travel north once again via Clearwater and beautiful Wells Gray Park where you will stop to view Spahats Falls. Chance of seeing wildlife abound in these parts; keep a lookout for mule dears, black bears and the many species of birds that live in the park. We continue our journey to Valemount. Accommodation: Comfort Inn & Suites | 1 Night.

Day 8: Jasper National Park

Sun 28 July 2024

This morning we will cross the Yellowhead Pass heading east passing Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Then, we will enjoy a full day of sightseeing in Jasper National Park. Highlights include Pyramid & Patricia Lakes drive. Next, follow the Maligne River Valley to Maligne Lake and stop for a walk in beautiful Maligne Canyon and to observe the ever changing water level of strange Medicine Lake. Enjoy a cruise on Maligne Lake to Spirit Island. Return to the townsite and ride up Jasper Tramway for panoramic views over the area – you will truly feel on top of world. Jasper offers great wildlife spotting opportunities for mule deers, white tail deers, elks, coyotes, marmots and bears. Overnight Jasper. Accommodation: Tonquin Inn | 1 Night



Day 9: Jasper / Lake Louise / Banff

Mon 29 July 2024

Early morning departure along the Icefield Parkway, one of the world's most beautiful highways, passing some of Canada's highest mountains and most magnificent glaciers. Stop at Athabasca and Sunwapta Falls before reaching Athabasca Glacier for a ride on the Ice Explorer onto Athabasca Glacier – a once in a lifetime opportunity! Continuing travelling south, you will pass Bow and Peyto lake on your way to famous Lake Louise to enjoy the spectacular view across the lake to the Victoria Glacier. Continue to Banff for our stay. Accommodation: Fox Hotel & Suites | 2 Nights

Day 10: Banff National Park

Tue 30 July 2024

Morning tour of Banff townsite passing the Bow River Falls, Tunnel Mountain Drive with the wind eroded hoodoos and Surprise Corner. Take a ride up the Sulphur Mountain with Banff Gondola for panoramic views of the surrounding mountains. Afternoon at leisure to take in the sites and enjoy the many possible activities.



Day 11: Banff / Rocky Mountaineer / Kamloops

Wed 31 July 2024

Early morning transfer to Banff train station. Travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from the resort town of Banff to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. Your journey takes you through a spectacular array of scenery as you travel between the glacier and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies, over mountain passes and through remarkable tunnels, along rocky lakeshores and across the ranchlands of the interior. Today's highlights include the Continental Divide, the Spiral Tunnels, the Kicking Horse Canyon, Rogers Pass and Craigellachie – where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven. Upon arrival in Kamloops you will be transferred to your hotel for overnight. Accommodation: With Rocky Mountaineer

Day 12: Kamloops / Rocky Mountaineer / Vancouver

Thu 01 August 2024

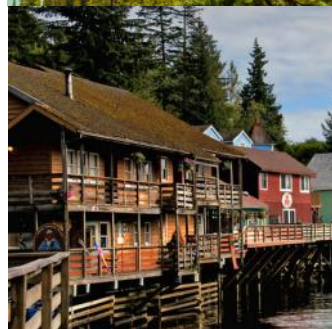
Early morning transfer back to Kamloops train station. Your journey continues west towards the Pacific Ocean and the coastal city of Vancouver. On today's journey you will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the interior, through winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser River Valley. Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. Your rail journey ends on arrival in Vancouver this evening. Transfer to your hotel downtown Vancouver. Accommodation: Vancouver Marriott Pinnacle Downtown | 2 Nights



Day 13: Vancouver

Fri 02 August 2024

A morning sightseeing tour of Vancouver begins with a drive around Stanley Park, stopping at the Totem Poles, then via Canada Place and the waterfront, Chinatown, North America's second largest and finally, historic Gastown with its 19th Century buildings, cobblestone streets and hidden passageways. Your city tour ends with a visit to Granville Island with its famous public market, art and craft shops and many cafes and restaurants. Afternoon at leisure for independent shopping and sightseeing.





Day 14: Vancouver Cruise departure **Sat 03 August 2024**
 Morning at leisure until your transfer to Vancouver Cruise terminal to board our Holland of America Alaskan Inside Passage cruise on the Koningsdam. Upon checking in, enjoy your Verandah Stateroom Cabins with floor to ceiling windows, a private balcony, a setting area with ensuite facilities for the next 7 nights.

Day 21: Vancouver Cruise arrival / Whistler **Sat 10 August 2024**

Arrival at Vancouver Cruise Terminal where the group will be met by their local guide. Your route today will follow the Sea to Sky Highway along beautiful Howe Sound. Pass through the coastal community of Britannia Beach where we will visit the Britannia Mine Museum, the greatest show under earth! Britannia Mine Museum opens up a little-seen world that fascinates all ages, turning out awe-inspiring sights and memorable family experiences. Rumble aboard our underground train as it rolls into authentic mining tunnels. Push up your sleeves and try our Gold Panning Pavilion where you can keep what you find. Explore 10 acres of historic buildings. BOOM!, an immersive, live-action special effects experience inside the historic Mill No. 3 building. Learn and engage with our interactive exhibits. Take a tour with informative but informal tour guides sharing fun facts about mining, history and life at Britannia. Next, stop at BC's highest waterfall, Shannon Falls and view the Stawamanus Chief, the second largest standing piece of granite in the world and popular rock-climbing area. Accommodation: Aava Hotel Whistler | 2 Nights

Day 22: Whistler **Sun 11 August 2024**

Enjoy a full day in the beautiful resort village of Whistler. Today you will take a trip on the Gondola for panoramic views of the Village and surrounding mountains, make sure to cross the Peak2Peak Gondola from Whistler to Blackcomb Mountain – a unique experience! Time at leisure for shopping and sightseeing in the village.

Day 23: Whistler / Vancouver **Mon 12 August 2024**

Morning departure towards Vancouver's North shore. Here we will visit Capilano Bridge, the longest suspension bridge in Canada. You will see the bridge, Treetops Adventure and new Cliffwalk exhibit. Next, take the Skyride to the top of Grouse Mountain. Experience the Theatre in the Sky presentations, visit the Bear Refuge, watch the Lumberjack Show and/or Birds of Prey Demonstration, take the quad chair to the Peak and take in the panoramic views over the city and the Georgia Strait. Late-afternoon return to downtown Vancouver. Accommodation: Aava Hotel Whistler

Day 24: Vancouver / Singapore / Adelaide **Tue 13 August 2024**

This morning, check in 3 hours prior to departure at Vancouver airport for your Singapore Airlines flight departing at 8:40am.

Day 25: In transit **Wed 14 August 2024**

In flight meals.
 Upon arrival in Singapore at 3:45pm, enjoy the airport facilities before reboarding at 11:10pm.

Day 26: Arrive Adelaide **Thu 15 August 2024**

On arrival at 7:25am, clear customs and immigration and make our way home.
